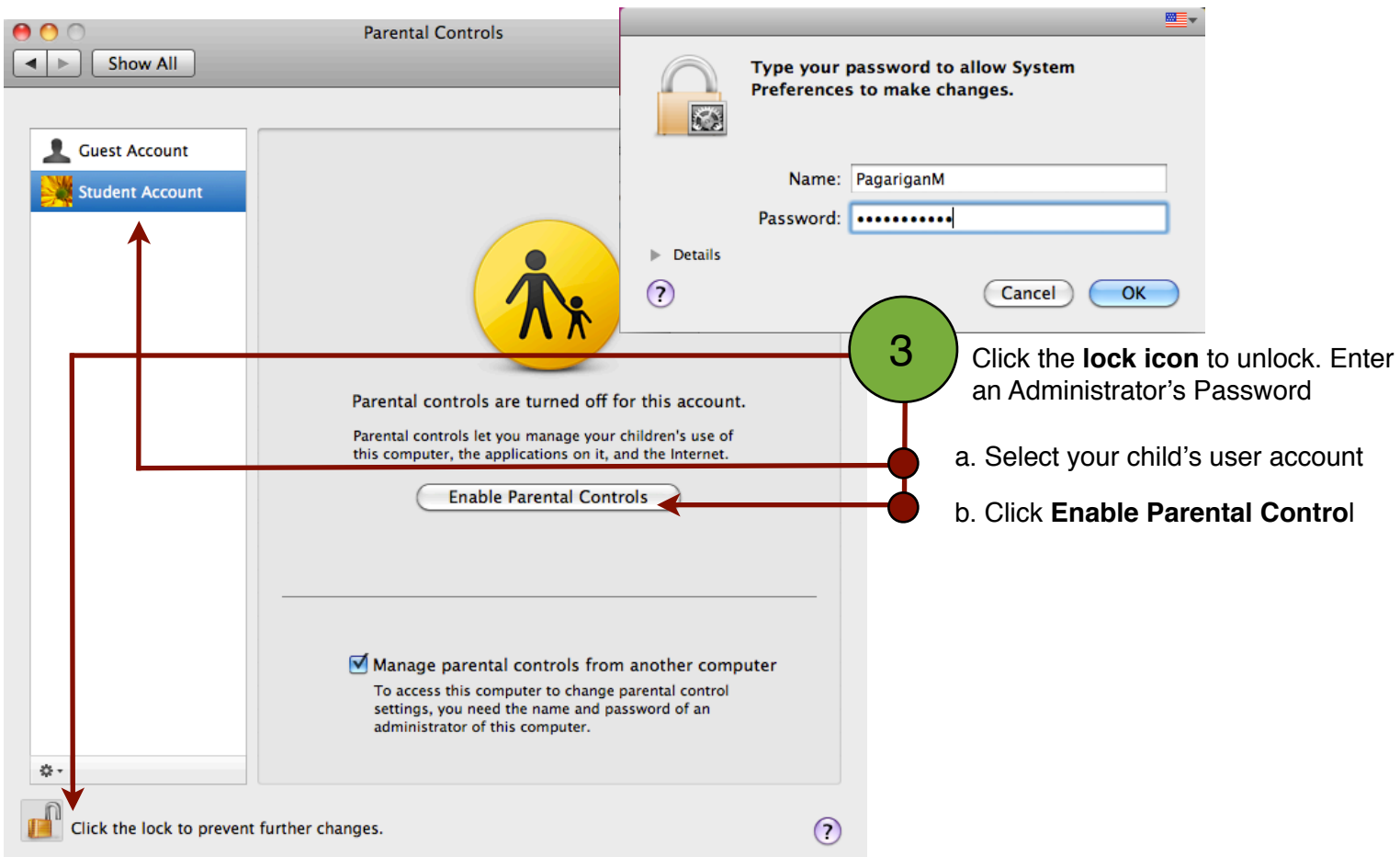
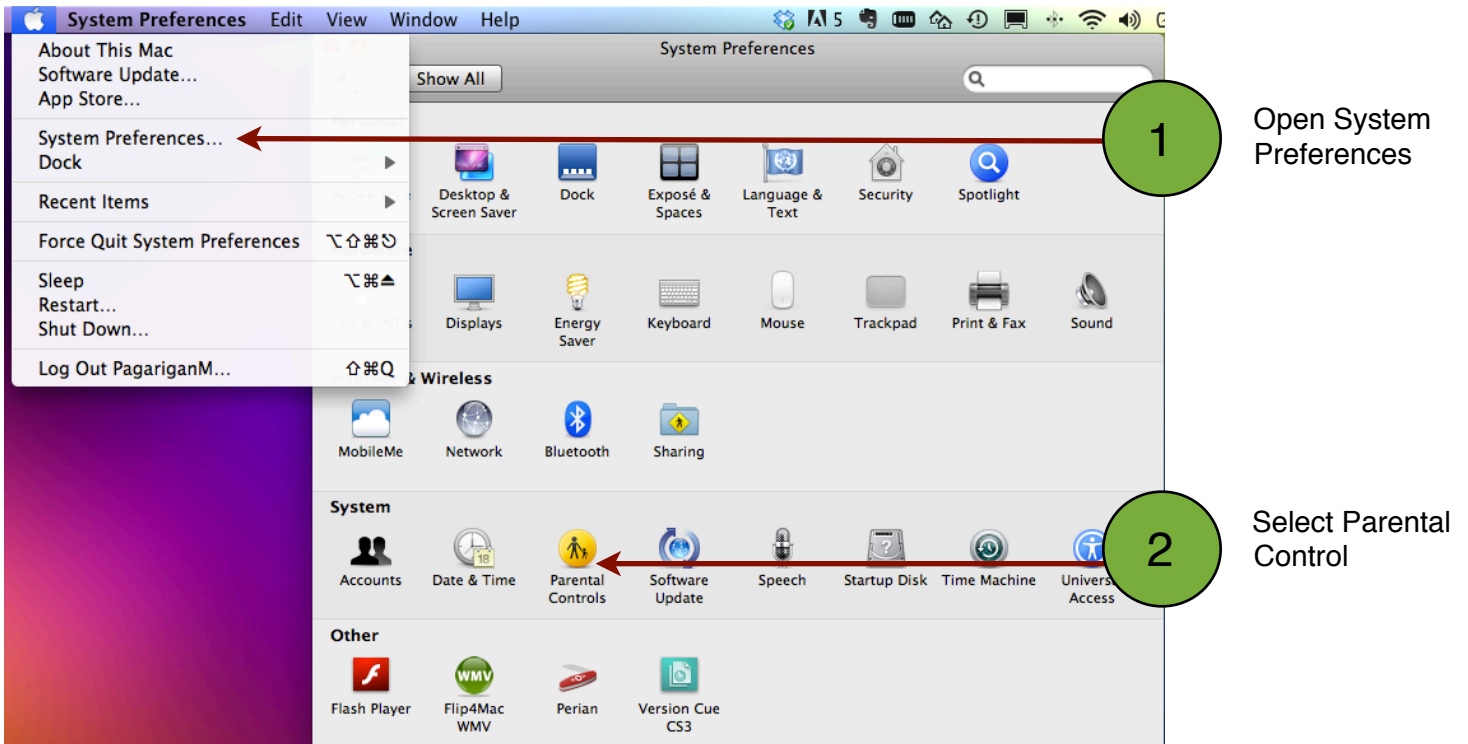


Setup Parental Controls on Your Mac

- Make sure to log-in with an Administrator's account
- Make sure that your child is using a Standard account NOT Administrator's, for you to set parental control.



Setup Parental Controls on Your Mac

Parental Controls

4 Select your child's Account Name to set parental control on

a. **Select Apps Tab:** To limit programs to use

b. **Use Simple Finder:** Provide simple view of the computer desktop

c. **Limit Applications:** Allows your child to open only the applications you specify on the list in the:

Allowed Apps box. You can click on the arrow to show the detailed list of programs in each category.

d. **Allow user to modify the dock**

Click the lock to prevent further changes.

6 **Select Web Tab:** To control your child's access to different websites on the Internet

7 **Website Restrictions:** Allows access only to websites with appropriate content or websites you specify.

8 **Try to limit access to adult websites:** To allow or deny access to specific websites, enter the website addresses in the lists below.

9 **Always allow these websites:** Add specific websites you ALWAYS allow your child to access

10 **Never allow these websites:** Add specific websites you NEVER allow your child to access

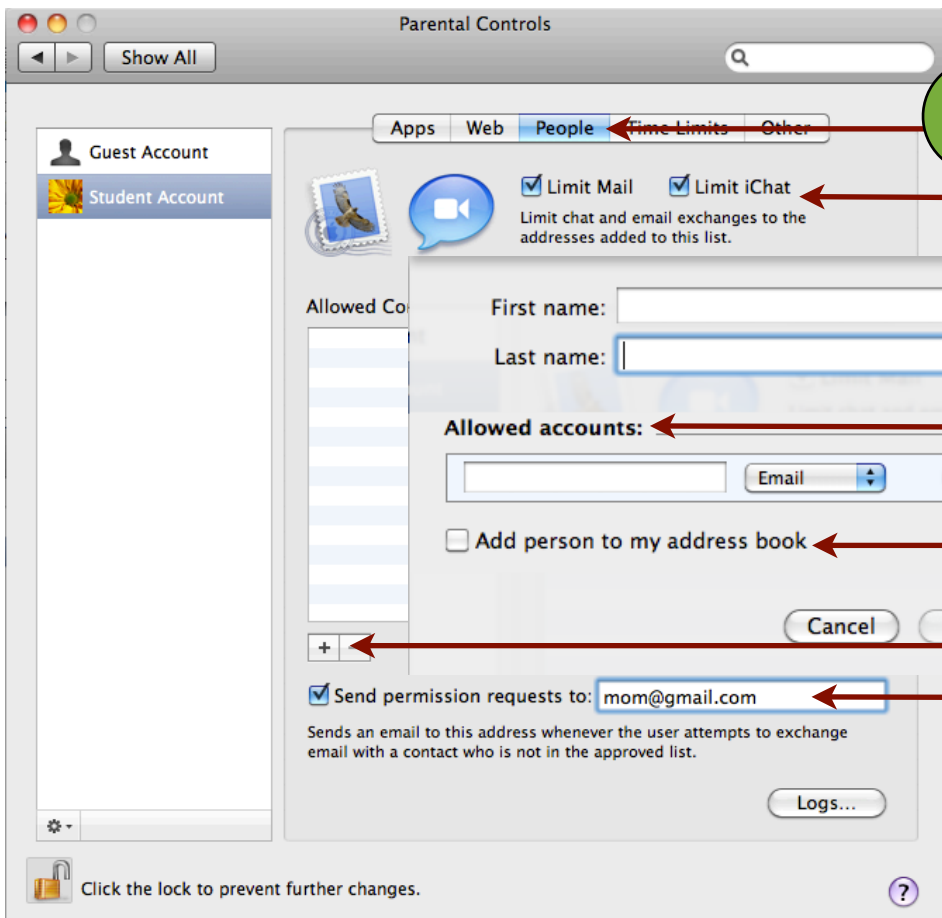

Setup Parental Controls on Your Mac



On the Web Tab: To Control your child's access to different websites on the Internet

- Allow Access **ONLY** to Specific Websites
- List of websites that can be accessed by your child
- Click the **+** sign to add more websites



On People Tab: To limit the number of people your child can contact

- Limit Mail and Limit Chat:** You can add a list of people that your child can contact
- Specify the contact information to add
- Add the information to your address book
- Click the **+** sign to add another contact
- Send permission request to your email whenever your child attempts to contact a person not in the list your specified

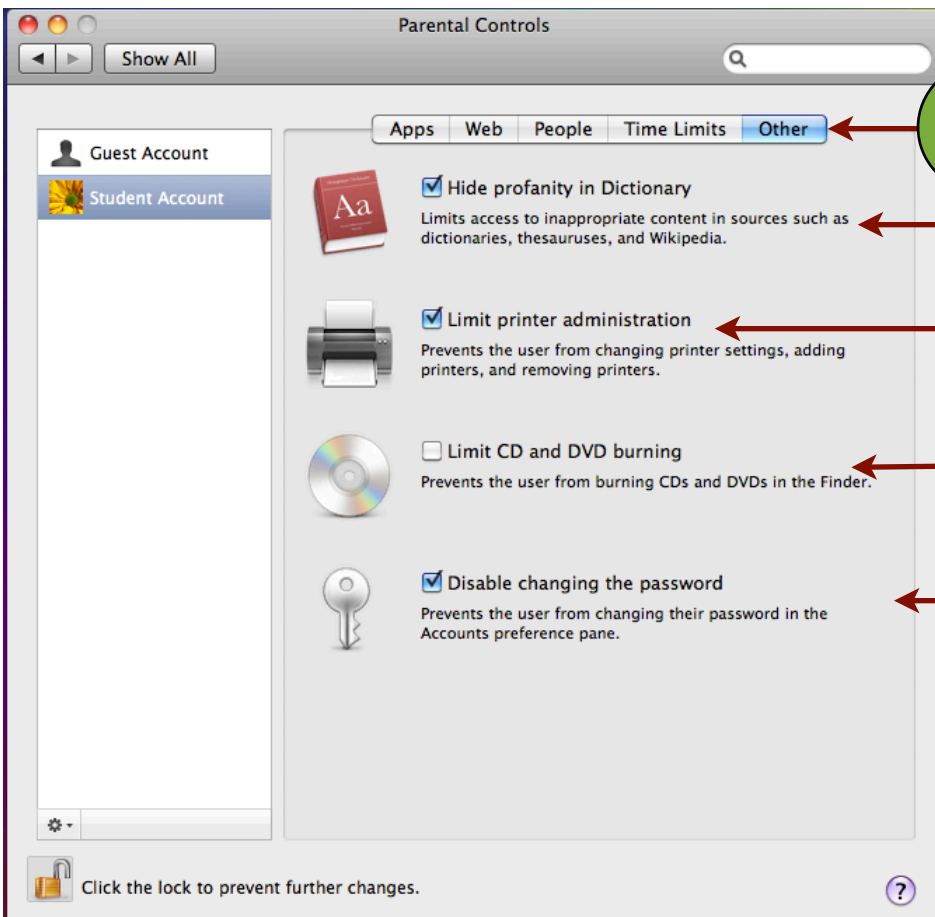


On Time Limits Tab: To limit the number of hours your child can use the the computer.
